Qualifications:

Applicant must possess at least a diploma certificate of nursing GNM or above with Mizoram Nursing Council Registration Certificate.

Skills and competencies:

- Knowledge of English and Mizo both written and oral.
- Effective communication skills, with demonstrated ability to talk and listen to patients and other health care personnel and build rapport with them.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide sufficient assessment along with implementing nursing interventions and communication evaluation of patient status.
- Facilitate communication amongst the healthcare team as well as patient and family.
- Recording patient vital signs and medical information.
- Monitoring, reporting and recording symptoms or changes in patient conditions.
- Administer medication as ordered and monitoring them for side effects and reactions.
- Maintaining accurate, complete health care records and reports.
- Provide education to patients and families regarding treatment plans.
